The Ohio Risk Assessment System (ORAS) is utilized to identify risk for recidivism (re-offending). Offenders who are identified as Moderate, High or Very High risk for re-offending on this assessment instrument are targeted for the program.

- NEOCAP addresses all criminogenic needs based on risk/needs assessments.
- 2. NEOCAP addresses the criminogenic needs of both single and married offenders.
- 3. NEOCAP works with offenders who are viably employed to maintain employment while at the same time addressing their other criminogenic needs.
- 4. Adult offenders who pose the highest risk for continued criminal conduct should be placed at NEOCAP regardless of age.
