

# Chirping Device Rules

1. You may only use your assigned device between 7:00 a.m. and 10:30 p.m.
2. You have 72 hours after you are issued the chirping device to have money in your chirping account. If it is not funded, the device will no longer work and you must return the device to staff.
3. You are not permitted to have or use your device in the kitchen or dining hall at any time.
4. You may not use your device during group sessions or case management sessions.
5. You must always keep your device in your possession and under your control.
6. You are not allowed to share, trade, or let another resident use your device.
7. You must store and charge your device in the designated location.
8. All messages are monitored. You have no expectation of privacy when using the device.
9. You may message individuals who accept your request, but all communication must follow facility rules.
10. Misuse of the device may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or loss of privileges.
11. You are financially responsible for any intentional damage or destruction of your device.
12. Chirping devices are a privilege that can be terminated by staff at any time.
